The ***Governor's Advisory Council on Education Relating to the Holocaust*** is a state funded program whose mission is to “develop programs throughout Nevada for the education of children and adults in issues relating to the Holocaust and to advise public and private bodies throughout the state on matters relevant to the Holocaust.”

- The Council sponsors the Sperling Kronberg Mack Holocaust Resource Center in Las Vegas whose librarian-educator holds classes and programs for teachers and students in the southern region. In Reno, the Shia Szut Memorial Holocaust collection is in the Northwest Library. In Elko, the Holocaust collection is housed in the Elko Library.
- Educators in Las Vegas, Reno and Elko hold classes and programs for students, teachers and the public.
- Conferences, programs, lectures, and films, sometimes in conjunction with the University of Nevada or other organizations, are offered.
- Holocaust survivors, their descendants, or authors often appear at relevant programs.
